Dear Parents,

Greetings from Ryan International Academy, Hinjawadi, Pune!

We are coming to the end of a glorious year with enriching and insightful learnings for all. We continue to strive in our mission to provide the best possible learning experience along with holistic development for our students.

School fees are the only source of income for the smooth functioning of the school academics and operations. As we will soon be ushering into the new academic session 2025-26, we are informing you about the school fee. The fee structure was discussed with the Executive Committee of the Parent Teacher Association in a meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2024. The fee structure is as appended below for your reference.

**Important Points to note:**

- Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.**
- Fees have to be paid by completing the signup process on our partner portal “Gray Quest” at the time of Admission, whereas fee Monthly installment deduction will begin from the bank account authorized by the parent on the 10th of each month starting from the month of GQ application sign up and EMI should end in the month of January 2026.**
- Fees Collection and GQ Application will start from 1 Feb 2025, The applications signed up for the month of Feb 25 will get the option of the 12 EMIs. And the EMI tenure will reduce based on the**

**month of sign up. Parents who want 12 EMIs should sign up in Feb 2025 and there 1<sup>st</sup> instalment will be deducted in Feb 2025**

4. In case of **Midterm TC**, GQ loan foreclosure charges are fully applicable to parents.
5. Transport fee will **NOT** be considered under GQ facility. This to be paid to the school directly
6. Parents will have option to pay fees in **lump sum** on or before **15<sup>th</sup> March 2025**
7. **Parents Interested to pay lump sum fee payment can avail 5% concession on the tuition Fees.**  
(excluding but not limited to- Non Academic fee, Vocational fee, Annual/Sports Day fee, Transport/Canteen/Day Care/Stationery/Books/Uniform etc.)
8. If any parents want to make **half yearly fee payment** towards the entire year's fees, they will be eligible for a 3% Discount on the Tuition fee payable excluding but not limited to Non-Academic fees, Vocational fees, Annual/Sports Day fees, Transport/Canteen/Day Care/Stationery/Books/Uniform etc. to avail half yearly discount we need to deposited PDC of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment along with the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment.
9. **In case of Sibling admissions, the second child will be eligible for a 10% concession on the tuition fees.**
10. If any one child is already studying with our school and the other one is admitted, then the newly admitted child will get a concession of 10% on the Tuition Fee only
11. Sibling concession is 10% but if a parent wants to pay lumpsum then a 5% concession is applicable only on net tuition fee amount after sibling concession.
12. Concession on yearly/half-yearly fee payment is available only for a limited time.
13. In staff concession - If staff wants to pay through GQ, the concession will be 45% only.
14. **Above Fees structure Includes:** Class Photo, Field Trip, School Magazine, Health Check up, Student Diary, Workbook / Worksheet, Parent App/Portal, Student & Parent ID Card, Foundation & Passion Initiatives.
15. **Exclusions in the above Fees, which are "Optional":** Transport, Day Care, Assets/Olympiad, After School Activities & School Excursions.
16. **Exclusions in the above Fees, which are "Mandatory":** School Uniform, Books & Stationery
17. **\*Vocational Initiatives – Opting any one program is mandatory and to be paid additionally:** Foreign Language, Coding, & Speech & Drama etc.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank each parent whose consistent support, faith, and patronage have helped us tide over the difficult times.
