Pre-primary I and Pre-primary II

Event 1: Fancy Dress Competition

Activity: Life Under Water: Save ME

- This is an individual event
- The participants should come dressed as any aquatic animal which is at the verge of extinct
- The participants must convey the message on the need to save life under water
- Each participant will be given 2 mins. for the presentation
- Teacher/guardian will not be allowed to dress the participant at the venue
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Event 2: Drawing and Colouring

Activity: Artist's Easel Depict what good health and wellbeing means to you

- This is an individual event
- The drawing sheet will be provided by the host school
- The participants should draw what good health and well being means to them
- 60 mins. will be given for drawing and colouring the picture
- The participants should bring their own colours
- The participants should use only colour pencils or crayons to colour their drawing
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Grades I and II

Event 1: Design Your Jewellery

Activity: The Design Challenge, Design your jewellery using natural materials

- This is a team event
- Each team will comprise of 3 participants
- The jewellery set will comprise a neck piece, one pair of earrings and a bracelet
- The participants must use only natural material to design their jewellery
- The participants must bring their own materials
- The jewellery design should be sketched first and the same should be made from scratch
- The participants will be given 120 mins. to design their jewellery
- The participants should give a name to their jewellery and list the materials used and the style used (if any)
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Judgement Criteria:

- Materials used (10)
- Creativity-Drawing and Name/style (10)
- Originality of Idea (10)
- Workmanship (10)
- Overall impact (10)

Event 2: Poem Recitation

Activity: Nature's Expressions, Spreading Awareness on Preserving Biodiversity

- This is an individual event
- The participants should recite a poem based on preserving biodiversity
- The participant should share the title, author and recite the poem
- The participant will be given 3 mins. to recite the poem
- The participants should bring 3 printed copies of the poem
- The participants will not refer to any printed materials during the presentation
- The poem must be recited as it appears in the judge's copy
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Grades III - V

Event 1: Poster Designing

Activity: Combat Climate Change

- This is an individual event
- The drawing sheet will be provided by the host school
- The participants should make the poster on combating climate change
- 90 mins.will be given to make the poster
- The participants should bring their own colours/materials
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Topic : Responsible Use of Resources-Production and Consumption

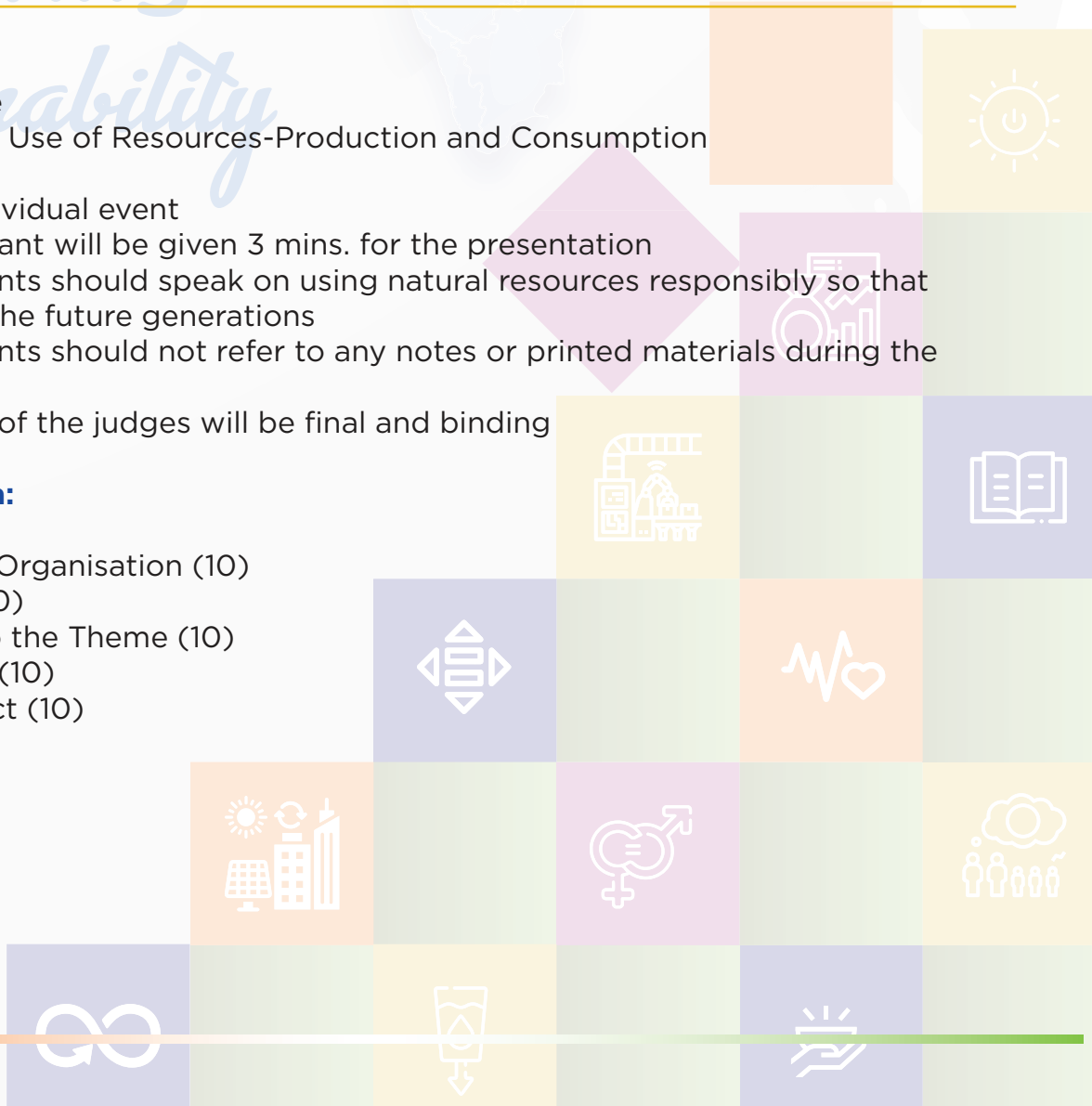
- This is an individual event

Event 1: Project Presentation

Activity: Change Makers-Promoting Sustainable Practices

- This is a team event
- Each team will comprise of 3 students
- All 3 students should be a part of the presentation
- The presentation should start by sharing the current practices and their impact on the society
- Then they share the change they would want to bring about to promote sustainable practices
- The steps to be followed for making the practice sustainable should also be shared creatively
- Powerpoint Presentation is not permitted
- Each team will be given 7 mins. to present
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Event 2: Street Play

Activity: Actomania

Topic: Stop Cruelty to Animals

- This is a team event
- Each team should comprise of minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 10 students
- Each team will get a maximum of 8 mins. to present the street play
- The team should choose the idea they want to present and give a title to the street play accordingly
- The street play should touch upon the idea of their choice and demonstrate its impact on people at large
- The street play should be presented in English or Hindi only
- The team can only use percussion instruments and use of electronic instruments is not permitted
- Each team should bring their own props
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Event 1: Model Making

Activity: Solar Power Applications

- The team should prepare one working model exhibiting the use of solar energy
- The team will get 90 mins. to put the model together and 8 mins. to present it
- The teams should be prepared to answer judge's questions
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Event 1: Art Installation

Activity: Creator's Corner- A depiction of Sustainable Living

- The team will be given 90 mins. to put together the set up
- Each team will get 5 mins. to talk about their installation
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
