Grades III to V

- Each question paper to be of 20 marks covering the entire portion.
- It will be a combination of objective and subjective type questions.
- Objective type questions can include MCQs, true or false and fill in the blanks and oneword answer based questions.
- Subjective type questions will include short and long answer type questions.

Languages

Section A - Reading Comprehension – 4 marks

Q1 - Short passage of 80-120 words.

- 4 MCQs of 1 mark each (out of these 1 should be based on testing vocabulary)

Section B – Writing Skill and Grammar – 8 marks

Q2 - 1 writing skill question of 3 marks (choice to be given if applicable)

Q3 - 5 marks Grammar

Section C – Literature – 8 marks

Q4 - Reference to context- 2 questions of 1 mark each- 2 marks

Q5 - 3 questions of 2 marks each

Other Subjects
