- **Community Service:** This should be based on student's participation in various Community Service Activities taken up by the school.
- **Art Education:** A 20 marks drawing test should be conducted at the end of each Term. This should be conducted during regular teaching period.
- **Health and Physical Education:** This should be based on the overall participation, enthusiasm and performance
- **Discipline:** This should be based on the observation of the teachers
