Three levels

There are three levels of the Cambridge English Qualifications tests - Pre A1 Starters, A1 Movers and A2 Flyers - for children in primary and lower secondary education. They start by learning simple words and phrases for Pre A1 Starters and progress to using extended and more challenging language in A1 Movers and A2 Flyers.
