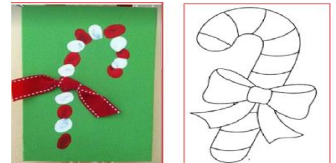
We are excited to announce a day filled with joy, love, and exciting activities on 20th December, making this Christmas extra special for our students.

- Mont 1: Finger Candy Stick making competition: Children will use their finger prints with alternate colours and decorate the candy stick.

- Mont 2: Christmas Tree Making

Material required: One A4 sheet (green) and few stickers or coloured paper cutouts

Note: Glue stick and crayons will be provided in the class.



- Mont 3: Paper Plate Baubles Making

Material required: One white paper plate (small) and craft paper cutouts of different colour. Students can use their own creativity and decorate these Baubles with glitter paper or decorative stickers.

- Grade 1 and 2: Paper Loop Christmas Tree Craft.

Material required: One white A4 sheet, yellow paper star, brown paper and green paper



- Grade 3 - 5: Story Narration Competition
