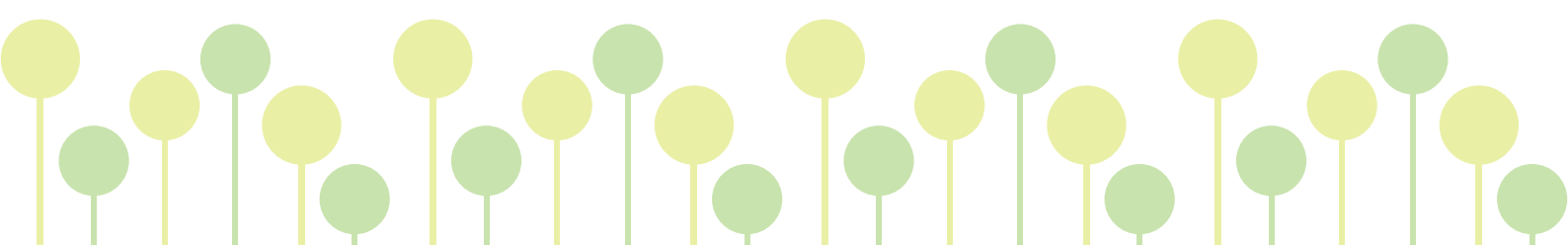

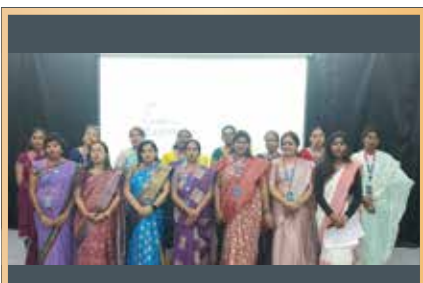


Lead By Example – Grades I to VI

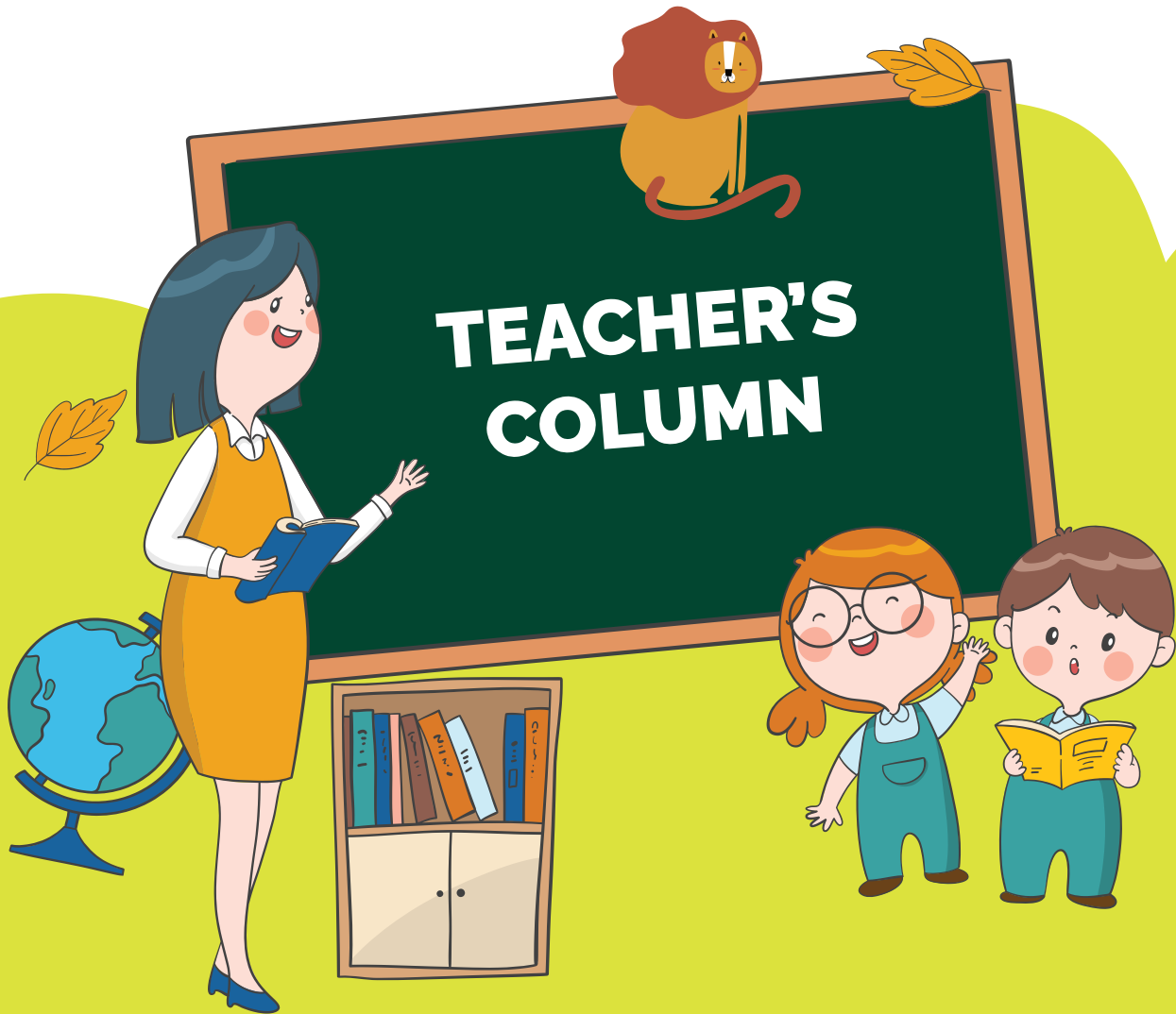


PARENT'S CORNER

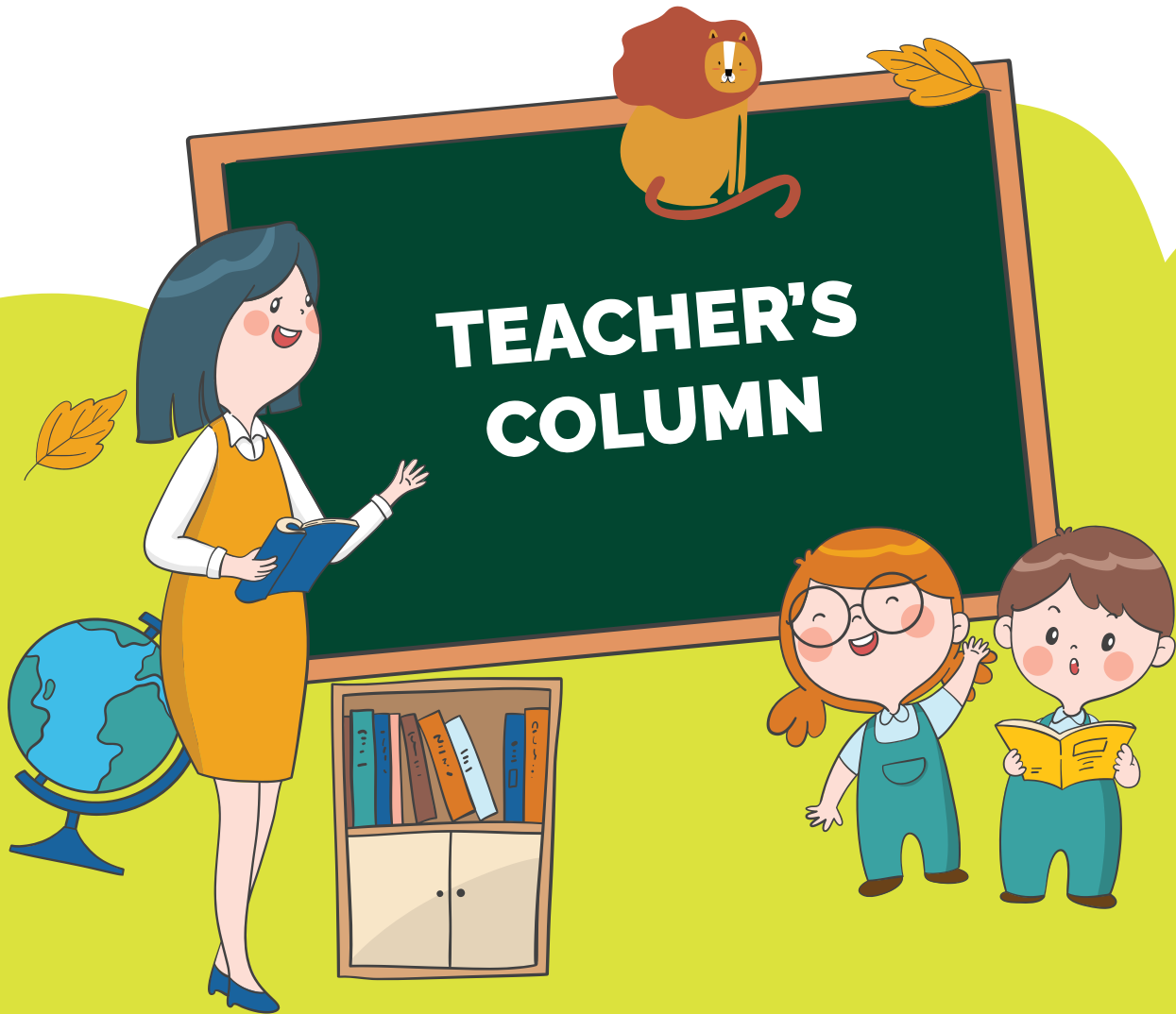
