### “The calmness inside You”!

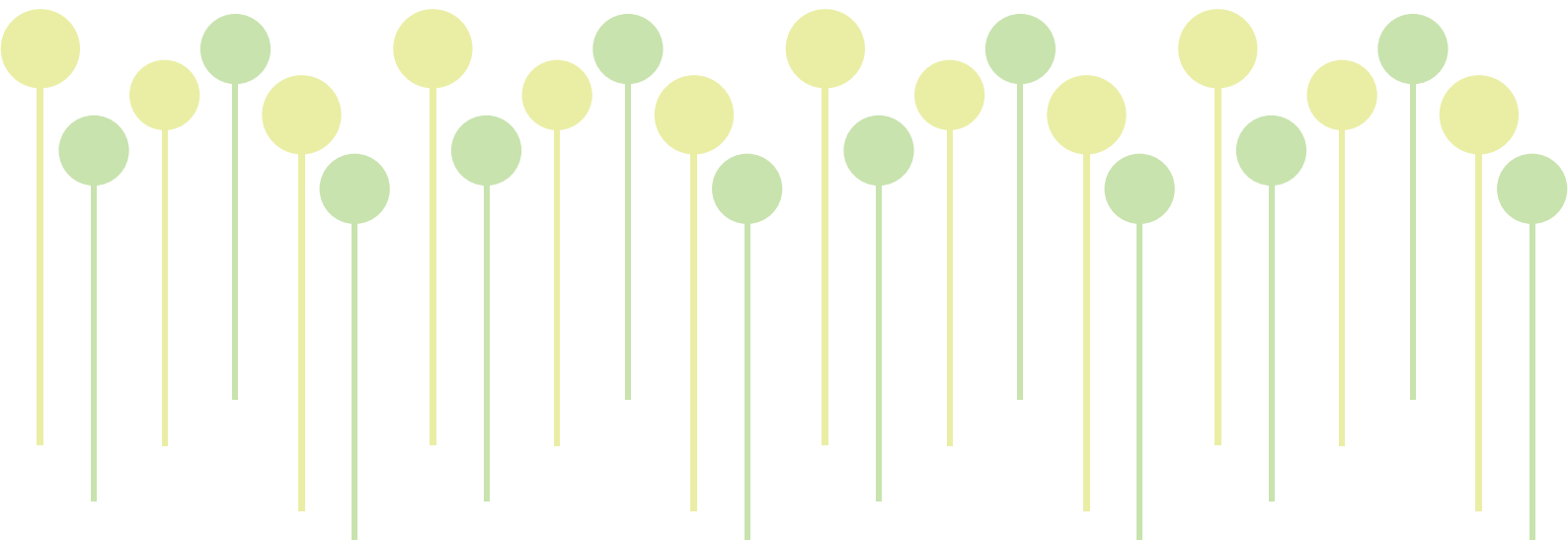

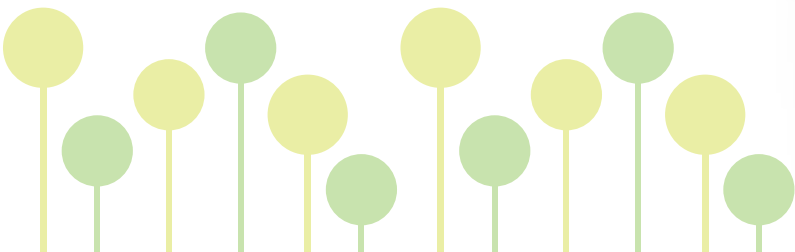
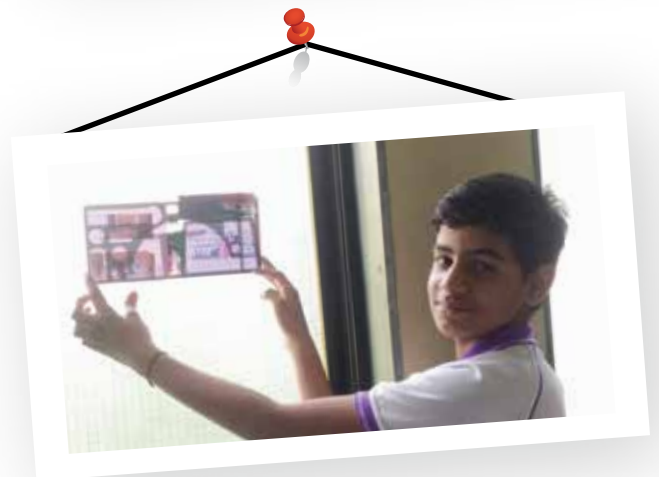
### Art Integrated Activity

## Special Assembly on Gudi Padwa

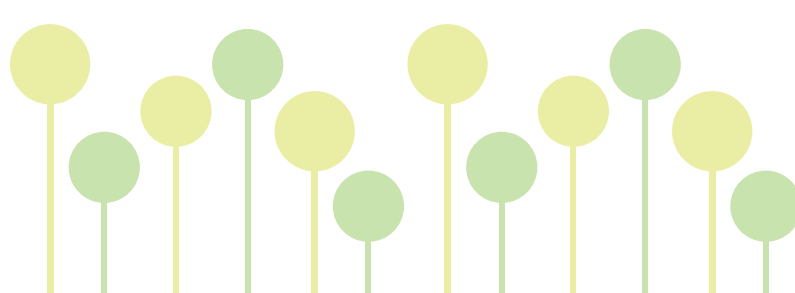
