


## **From the Headmistress Desk**

## **Aditya L1 Mission Timeline - Grade VI**

#### Here's a simplified version:

2014: Initial discussions about a dedicated solar mission begin.

**2018:** The project receives approval from the Indian government.

**2020:** Mission objectives and scientific payloads are finalized.

**2021:** The spacecraft's design and development commence.

2022: Testing of components and systems begins.

2023 (September): Successful launch of Aditya L1 from the Satish

Dhawan Space Centre.

**2023 (October):** The spacecraft enters its trajectory towards the L1 point.

**2024:** Expected arrival at the L1 point and commencement of scientific operations.
