National Milk Day Grade I & II


Fun Cow Drawing



Paste Wool on the Tentacles of the Octopus



Winter Nature Walk


Students went on a winter nature walk and observed the seasonal changes around them. They later sat under a tree and drew what they saw, connecting closely with nature and expressing their creativity.

Introduction to Coding




