Dance

Dance is not just about steps; it is a beautiful way for children to develop rhythm, creativity, and confidence. Our students have been actively learning dance, and each month brought new skills and experiences.

Rhythm and Basic Movements - Mont I

Students were introduced to the world of dance through simple **rhythmic exercises** and body movements. They learnt how to move in time with music, maintain posture, and enjoy expressing themselves freely. This foundation helped them build balance and coordination.

Coordination and Teamwork - Mont II

The focus was on synchronization and group practice. Students discovered how important it is to observe each other, stay in rhythm, and move as a team. This not only improved their dance coordination but also instilled values of discipline, cooperation, and teamwork.

Expression and Stage Confidence - Mont III

The emphasized expressions and performance skills. Students learnt how to use gestures,

emotions, and stage presence to make their dance more meaningful. Performing in front of peers boosted their **self-confidence and expressive abilities.**

Through this dance learning, students gained much more than steps and moves. They developed **rhythm**, **coordination**, **teamwork**, **expression**, **and confidence**—skills that will help them both on and off the stage. Dance has truly become a joyful medium of growth and creativity for our young learners.



For Montessori children, I introduced and practiced the song "You Are My Sunshine" song and Practiced We shall overcome song. Additionally, I conducted rhythm exercises by demonstrating with percussion instruments.

These activities helped the children enjoy singing, explore musical sounds, and begin developing a sense of rhythm through interactive practice.

Physical Education

Journey of the Students in Physical Education of Montessori classes.....

In their Physical Education classes, the Montessori students have explored a variety of games and activities. They practiced locomotor skills such as running, jumping, hopping, and balancing, which improved their coordination and body control.

The activities also encouraged focus, concentration, and agility, helping the children become more attentive and confident in their

movements. With each session, they strengthened their physical abilities and developed better body awareness.

This journey has nurtured their individual growth, building both fitness and confidence, while instilling in them the joy of movement and active participation.

Innovation Lab

The month of July 2025 was an exciting journey for our Montessori children at Ryan International Academy. Magadi. learning began with an orientation in the **STEAM Lab,** where the little ones explored the environment and were introduced to basic STEAM concepts in a fun way. They participated in a creative activity on **Healthy** and Unhealthy Foods, where they sorted pictures and learned to make wise food choices, understanding the importance of nutrition. Another hands-on session, Fun with Numbers, engaged them with coins to compare values, identify greater and smaller numbers, and strengthen early math skills. These activities not only enhanced their observation and problem-solving abilities but also built strong foundations in healthy living and number sense. The month was filled exploration. active with ioyful participation, and meaningful learning experiences.

Farm Animals - Mont I

Our little learners had an exciting and hands-on session where they explored the uses of farm animals! We introduced the topic using real items such as eggs, honey, wool, and milk to help the children connect with the learning in a fun and interactive way.


