The parent orientation program was conducted for new admission students of Mont I to grade VII on 1st June 2024. There were a total of 98 parents in the program.

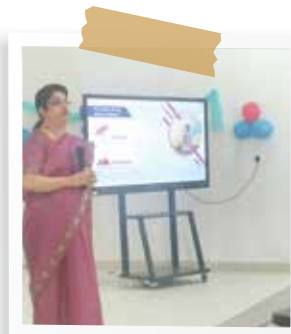

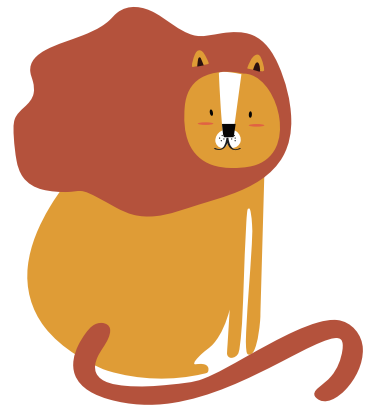

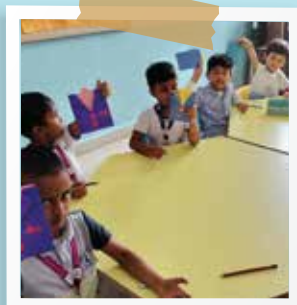




Father's Day - Mont I to III

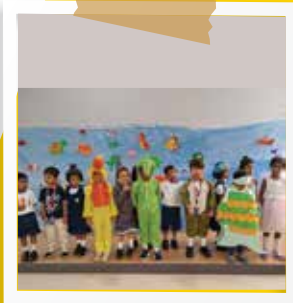
World Ocean Day - Mont I to II

World Bicycle Day – Mont I to III

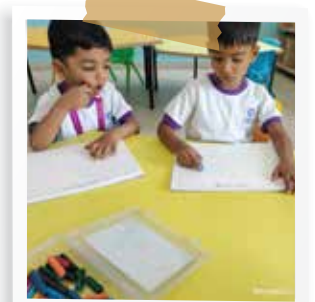
‘Promoting Health, Equity, Sustainability through Cycling

Counting and Matching – Mont III

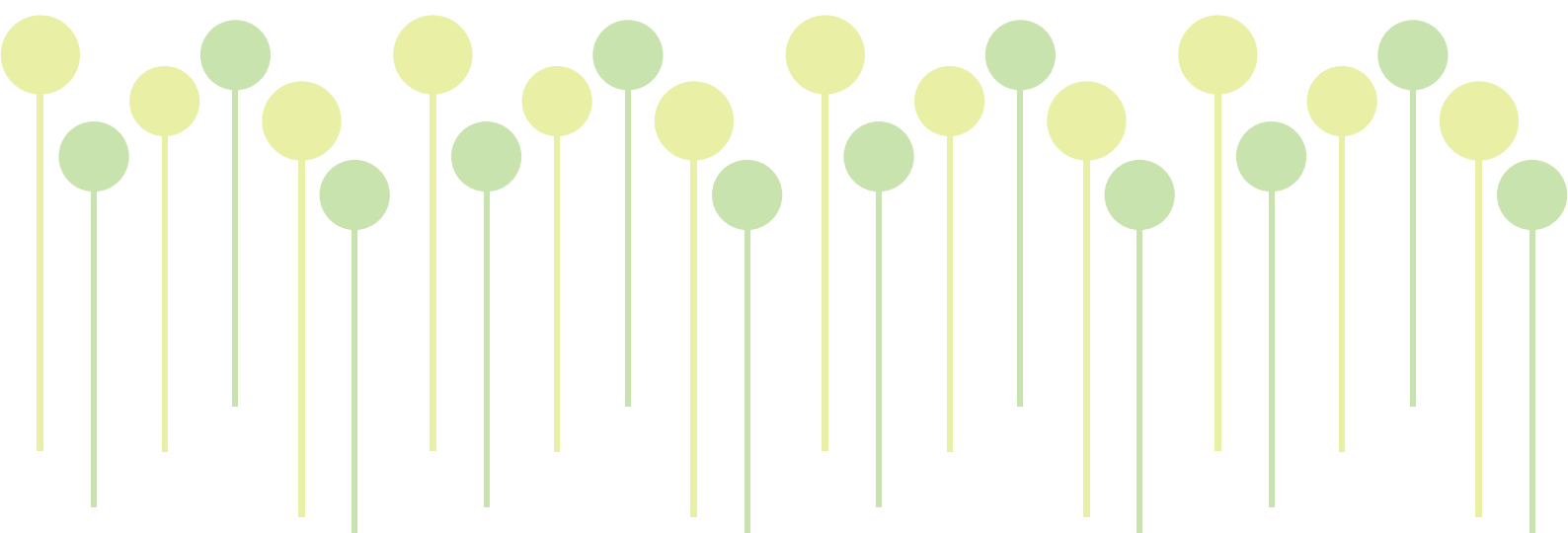
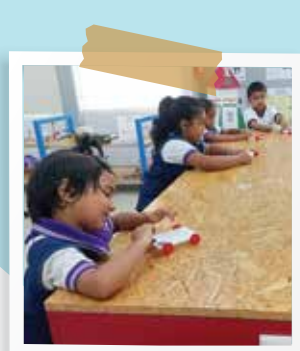

Magnet Car – Mont III

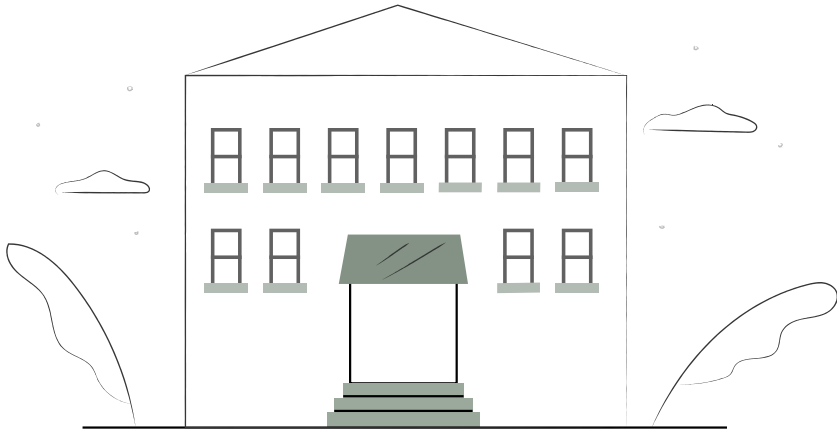
