Effectiveness of play way method of Learning

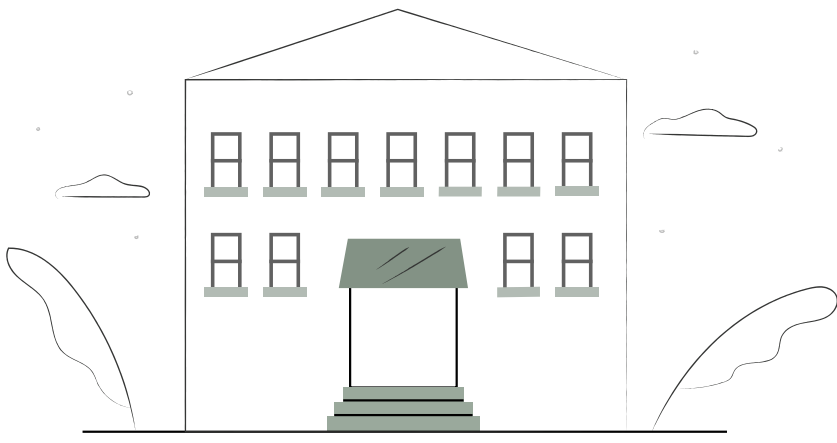
Literacy play can be a fun way of engaging preschoolers.

Play-way method allows children to communicate, share ideas and listen to others. Children develop empathy and build better and stronger relationships through play-way activities. They develop skills required for teamwork, learn how to stand out in a crowd and cooperate with others when there is a common goal.

Play-way assures maximum freedom for the child with the result that he develops originality, power of reasoning, imagination and insights. Play-way gives training in the democratic way of life. The students learn to co-operate and to help each other. Play-way stimulates mutual goodwill and fellow feelings.
